

Task: Character Analysis WONDER

In this task, you will analyse one of the characters from *Wonder* using a technique called *Book Bento*. A Bento, traditionally, is a box that contains different kinds of food in order to create a nutritious meal. We will explain what a *book bento* is here - this worksheet will take you through the process step by step:

- Choose any character from the novel *Wonder* except for August, the protagonist. NOTE: it should be a character that you know a good deal about and whose actions and behaviour you feel you understand.
- Collect 4-5 objects that have something to do with this character or say something about them (for August, for example, this might be his Halloween costume, his helmet, or a scalpel indicating all the surgeries he has had).
- Place these objects on a flat surface around your copy of the book. You can find examples here:

- Take a picture which captures the book and all of the objects
- Next, think carefully about how each object helps you to understand the character and his / her development. Prepare notes that will help you to speak about your analysis of the character.
- Record yourself speaking about the character and their role in the novel (3-4 mins). Make sure to speak clearly and practice a few times before you record.

Your analysis is due the same date as your class test. You will find an assignment on MS TEAMS where both the image and your voice recording will be uploaded.

You will be graded based on creativity, depth and precision of analysis, punctuality and correctness of language and pronunciation.
